## **Block 1 – Foundations of the Entrepreneurial Mindset**

## **Block 3 – Risk Thinking, Experimentation & Learning**

- Experimentation and pilot thinking
- Learning from failure and feedback
- Reducing fear of uncertainty

## **Block 4 – Ownership, Accountability & Bias for Action**

- Bias for action versus over-analysis**
- Balancing speed and judgment**
