LEARNING STRUCTURE (8 HOURS)

Block 1 – Foundations of Resource & Budget Planning

This session builds a strong foundation by explaining why resource and budget planning are critical to successful execution. Participants understand how poor planning leads to overruns, delays, and stress, and why disciplined planning improves predictability and trust.

It covers:

- Purpose of resource and budget planning
- Relationship between scope, time, and cost
- Common planning mistakes
- The role of accountability in planning

Block 2 – Defining Scope & Resource Requirements

This session focuses on understanding what resources are truly required to deliver work. Participants explore how unclear scope and assumptions lead to inaccurate planning and rework.

- Identifying required skills and capacity
- Avoiding under- or over-estimation
- Aligning resources with objectives

Block 3 – Estimating Costs & Effort Realistically

- Managing uncertainty in estimates
- Avoiding optimism bias

Block 4 – Budget Planning & Approval Processes

This session addresses how budgets are planned, reviewed, and approved. Participants understand how to present budget information clearly and responsibly.

- Navigating approval processes
- Documenting assumptions

Block 5 – Resource Allocation & Capacity Management

This session focuses on allocating resources effectively across competing demands. Participants learn how over-allocation reduces productivity and increases risk.

- Adjusting allocations proactively

Block 6 – Tracking Spend, Usage & Variance
