LEARNING STRUCTURE (8 HOURS)

Block 1 – Foundations of Scenario Planning

This session builds a strong foundation by explaining what scenario planning means in modern organizations and why it is essential in uncertain, complex environments. Participants develop clarity on how scenario planning differs from forecasting and why it helps organizations prepare rather than predict.

It covers:

- What scenario planning is and what it is not
- Difference between forecasts, plans, and scenarios
- Why uncertainty cannot be eliminated
- Value of multiple future perspectives

Block 2 – Understanding Uncertainty, Trends & Driving Forces

This session focuses on identifying and understanding the forces that shape future outcomes. Participants learn how trends, uncertainties, and external drivers interact and why not all trends are equally important.

It covers:

- Key trends and uncertainties
- Internal vs external driving forces
- Political, economic, social, technological, and regulatory influences
- Separating predictable trends from true uncertainties

Block 3 – Defining Critical Uncertainties & Scenario Axes

This session strengthens the ability to narrow focus by identifying the most critical uncertainties that will shape future scenarios. Participants learn how to frame uncertainty clearly and construct meaningful scenario structures.

It covers:

- Identifying high-impact, high-uncertainty factors
- Prioritizing uncertainties
- Building scenario axes
- Avoiding overly complex or unrealistic scenarios

Block 4 – Developing Plausible & Coherent Scenarios

This session focuses on building realistic, internally consistent scenarios rather than extreme or unlikely outcomes. Participants learn how to describe alternative futures that challenge assumptions and stimulate strategic thinking.

Creating plausible scenario narratives

Ensuring internal consistency

Exploring implications across functions

Avoiding bias and wishful thinking

Block 5 – Strategic Implications & Option Testing

This session addresses how scenarios are used to test strategies, plans, and decisions. Participants learn how different futures expose risks, opportunities, and blind spots.

Testing strategies against scenarios

Identifying vulnerabilities and strengths

Exploring strategic options

Understanding trade-offs across scenarios

Block 6 – Scenario Planning for Risk & Resilience

This session focuses on using scenarios to improve organizational resilience and risk preparedness. Participants learn how scenario thinking supports contingency planning and adaptive responses.

Building flexibility into plans

Reducing surprise and reaction time

Block 7 – Integrating Scenarios into Decision-Making

- Supporting leadership decisions
- Communicating scenarios to stakeholders
- Avoiding scenario overload

Block 8 – Personal Scenario Planning Action Plan

This final session focuses on long-term application and practical integration. Participants consolidate learning, identify where scenario thinking can support their roles, and build habits for considering multiple futures in planning, risk assessment, and decision-making.
